Race Reports

BC Cup #4 - Cross(Port)Coquitlam - Port Coquitlam, BC - October 24

Jean Ann continued to turn heads on her Xprezo Ultra Hop cyclocross bike and strengthen her BC Cup Series lead! She won BC Cup #4 in Port Coquitlam in sunny conditions with "just enough water on the course to make it a little slippery." Joele Guynup and Kelly Jones chased hard for the first few laps until Kelly went down hard on a leafy, wet cornerd and injured her shoulder. Joele finished 2nd, and Local Ride Racing teammate Chelsea took 3rd.



BC Cup #5 - Pumpkin Cross - Maple Ridge, BC - October 25

After 3 years of Local Ride's annual Pumpkin Cross races, Jean Ann finally stood on the top step. "I think the Jean-Animal costume may have helped me out," she said, referring to the getup in which she won the Halloween-themed race. "It was cold out, and I needed the fur." After Sandra and Joele initiated a World Cup start, the Jean-Animal sprinted to the grassy corners first. Joele got around and they battled until Jean Ann growled menacingly and made the pass. Sandra finished 3rd, with Chelsea 4th.



Sandra enjoyed her race, but disappointedly came up short in the costume contest, which she entered as Super-Clean Girl. "I guess people are just afraid of what they don't understand," she said. "They chose the Incredible Hulk instead of my original creation. I still think the Hulk is juiced, but if WADA can't prove it, what can you do? That's okay. I'll try again next year."

Jean Ann won the Team Coastal Cross event the following weekend: "I was disappointed that no other women in my category showed up," she said, but "I was lucky to get to mix it up with the guys in the B race."



Jean Ann found success in her first-ever track competition when she won the women's 25-lap tempo race on a rainy Friday night at the Burnaby Velodrome, plus she showed her strength and skill in other races against some national-calibre riders.

"I tried my luck in a couple of the Women's and B Omnium races, which included a scratch race, miss and out, points race, and tempo race. These are all new events to me, and I found they are very fun games," she said.

She has a lot to learn, but she's already flying! Only a week before, she was tested at a National Team Development Camp at Burnaby's 200m indoor cycling track, where the overseeing coaches recognized her talent. They were so impressed, they invited her to a National Track Team Training Camp in Los Angeles, which runs this week!





Daryl Evans Gran Prix - South Surrey, BC - November 15

Local Ride Racing's Jean Ann proved she's truly hardcore on Sunday (like there was ever a question!) at the South Surrey Bike Park on a very rainy (read monsoon), windy, and cold day of cyclocross racing.
